

PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION

Pursuant to Article 13(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation), hereinafter referred to as the “GDPR”, we inform that:

1. The controller of personal data is the University of Lodz, based in Lodz, Narutowicza 68, 90-136 Lodz, Poland.

3. Personal data including: first name(s) and surname(s), email address, gender, university name, level of interest in implementing social innovations, level of interest in cooperation with non-governmental organizations will be processed for the following purposes:
 - Recruitment for the training activity carried out within the Project “Bravely for Innovation: A Program for Educating Social Innovators in the Visegrad Countries”, co-financed by the governments of the Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland, and Slovakia through the Visegrad Fund, project number: 22530248.
 - Reporting on the implementation of the Project “Bravely for Innovation: A Program for Educating Social Innovators in the Visegrad Countries”, co-financed by the governments of the Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland, and Slovakia through the Visegrad Fund, project number: 22530248.
 - Communication with Participants/Candidates of the training regarding matters related to the training activity carried out within the Project “Bravely for Innovation: A Program for Educating Social Innovators in the Visegrad Countries”, co-financed by the governments of the Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland, and Slovakia through the Visegrad Fund, project number: 22530248.
 - Issuance of certificates confirming completion of the training related to the training activity carried out within the Project “Bravely for Innovation: A Program for Educating Social Innovators in the Visegrad Countries”, co-financed by the governments of the Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland, and Slovakia through the Visegrad Fund, project number: 22530248.

Personal data in the form of image and full name will be used for:

4. Personal data will be processed on the basis of:

- Article 6(1)(e) of the GDPR in conjunction with Articles 2 and 11 of the Act of 20 July 2018
- Polish Law on Higher Education and Science;
- Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR;
- Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR;
- Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR based on your consent (in the case of consent to the use of image).

5. Where the processing of personal data is based on consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing carried out before its withdrawal.

6. Recipients of your personal data may include entities authorized under the law or entities entrusted by the Controller with data processing under a contract. Your personal data (in the form of recorded image) may also be processed by service providers: YouTube (Google LLC) and Facebook (Meta Platforms), as well as partners of the Organizer of the 11th Seminar on Methodology of Pedagogy.

7. Personal data will be stored for the period necessary to achieve the purposes referred to in point 3, and for the period of retention of financial and accounting documentation of the 11th Seminar on Methodology of Pedagogy by the University of Lodz.

8. You have the right to:

- access your personal data,
- rectify your data if it is inaccurate,
- request deletion, restriction of processing, and data portability,
- object to data processing,
- lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority.

Providing your personal data is voluntary, but necessary to achieve the purposes referred to in point 3.
